<b>Task: <i>Streamline Program Offerings</i></b>
Form a Single Area F Curriculum for Business Majors
<b>Recommendation and/or Action Taken:</b> The core Area F for Business majors at Georgia State University and Georgia Perimeter should be consolidated in keeping with University System of Georgia requirements to form a single core curriculum. See Appendix A for specific recommendations for Area F.
Determine any Non-Core Requirements (Health, Phys. Ed., etc.)
<b>Recommendation and/or Action Taken:</b> Recommends the removal of / exclusion from Area F for BBA majors any Non-Core Requirements (Health, Phys. Ed., etc.). The Committee defers to the Recommendations of the General Education and Core Curriculum on these Additional Requirements, currently in the Georgia Perimeter College program for Business majors.
Coordinate delivery of freshman orientation classes for pre-business students
<b>Recommendation and/or Action Taken:</b> To the extent that other committees agree to expand the equivalent of GSU 1010 to GPC as part of the consolidation, Committee 2 recommends that sections of any such orientation program for pre-Business students be coordinated with RCB's student orientation program and taught by full time faculty members in the college, as currently done in RCB.
Coordinate delivery of Perspectives classes oriented to and staffed by business faculty members
<b>Recommendation and/or Action Taken:</b> To the extent that Committee 7's recommendation for three Perspectives courses, PERS 2001, PERS 2002 and PERS 2003 are included in the catalog following consolidation, Committee 2 recommends that courses be developed and delivered under all three variation by both RCB and GPC faculty members
