RECOMMENDATIONS PRESENTED AT 6/4 CIC MEETING NEEDING FURTHER DISCUSSION

[ORIGINAL RECOMMENDATIONS:](#)

1. Recommends that Brightspace by D2L course start and end dates be set by default so that no early access is permitted allowing No-Show reporting to be strictly enforced:

Allowing students early access to online courses interferes with established No-Show Attendance windows. Access to online courses must coincide with the No-Show Attendance windows so that students in online and face-to-face courses are held to the same attendance standards.

REASON FOR RETURN: Concerns with the timing of the “No-show” reporting window and no early access to Brightspace by D2L. Need to rewrite and resubmit.

[NEW RECOMMENDATION:](#)

1. Recommends that early access to online courses must include a message announcing the No-Show Quiz that will occur during the No-Show Attendance reporting period established by the University:

Participation in online courses must coincide with the No-Show Attendance windows so that students in online and face-to-face courses are held to the same attendance standards. Completion of a quiz provides motivation and an assurance of compliance needed for our recording purposes.

2. Recommends that syllabi be available online to students outside of Brightspace by D2L:

Access to syllabi within Brightspace by D2L will be denied until the first day of a semester or term. Faculty will be responsible for providing a syllabus in an alternative centralized online location.

REASON FOR RETURN: If concerns with recommendation 1 are addressed/rectified Recommendation two may become unnecessary.

RECOMMENDATION 2 WITHDRAWN:

We are withdrawing Recommendation 2 and taking the advice of the committee to reflect this recommendation in our revised recommendation 1.

ORIGINAL RECOMMENDATIONS:

9. Recommends that all faculty and students should continue to be able to access online vendor training from Lynda.com:

Students and faculty need to continue to access convenient just-in-time resources that focus not just on technology skills but also on presentation, resume writing, and leadership skills as offered by Lynda.com.

REASON FOR RETURN: As Lynda.com was sold don't want to name a specific program. Need to rewrite and resubmit.

NEW RECOMMENDATION:

9. Recommends that all faculty and students should continue to have access to online training provided by an appropriate vendor to enhance their teaching and learning skills:
